Flood Re is playing a crucial role in making UK homes more resilient to flooding, but there's still plenty of work ahead. With one in four homes at risk of flooding in the UK and extreme weather events becoming more frequent, it's vital that homeowners have access to **affordable flood insurance** —something Flood Re has provided since 2016.

One of the biggest steps forward has been the **Build Back Better** initiative, launched in 2022, which has already secured the commitment of 77% of the UK insurance market. This program is helping homeowners who have experienced flooding to install **property flood resilience (PFR) measures**, reducing future risks. Real-world examples, like Roy from Worksop, who installed flood barriers and non-return valves after a flood in 2022, and Sandra in Oxfordshire, who was left stranded during a flood

but later secured her home with resilience measures, show the positive impact of the initiative.

Flood Re isn't stopping there. We are working to **mainstream PFR** through innovative efforts like **Flood Performance Certificates (FPCs)** — a system designed to help homeowners measure and demonstrate their flood protection levels. As climate change continues to drive wetter, more unpredictable weather, Flood Re's collaboration with the government and insurance industry remains essential to ensuring homes across the UK are better prepared and properly insured.

Build Back Better

Build Back Better (BBB) is designed to reduce the cost and impact of future floods by including property resilience measures as part of flood repairs. The initiative offers householders the chance to install property flood resilience measures up to the value of £10,000 when repairing their properties after a flood.

If you want your home insurance policy to include BBB speak to your broker or insurer before committing to purchase your policy as each insurance provider's offering may differ.



Preparing for a flood

A Flood Ready House

Examples of flood resistance products, flood recoverable measures and a room prepared for a flood



1 Grass and plants rather than paved areas

2 Rain planter for runoff from garage roof

3 Closed-cell type insulation in cavity walls

4 Ensure the pointing is sound and breathable waterproofing cream on external walls

5 Self-closing airbricks

6 Sump/pump below floor level inside garage to remove water

7 Flood barriers can better protect garage... **but try to move vehicles to higher ground** as soon as possible!

8 Permeable paving surface on driveway

9 Inflatable toilet bung

10 Pathways of gravel over weed-suppressant fabric

11 White goods on raised plinths in utility area

12 Non-return valves in sewer pipe

13 Separate electrical circuit for upper and lower floors

14 Recoverable kitchen units such as plastic or stainless steel, or on legs concealed by removable kickboards

15 Wall-mounted boiler

16 Fridge on raised plinth

17 Electrical sockets raised

18 Tiled floors, with waterproof adhesive and waterproof grout

19 Recoverable plaster OR plasterboard laid horizontally

20 Sump/pump at lowest point inside house to remove water

21 Easily accessed storage for flood barriers and equipment

22 Permeable paving surface on pathway

23 Bottom two steps made of concrete and with removable carpet

24 Sentimental items, important items and documents kept upstairs

25 Flood resistant front door

26 Furniture raised on trestles

27 Plastic, solid wood or tiled skirting boards

28 Solid wood or removable internal doors with rising butt hinges

29 Items from low shelves put on high shelves in plastic boxes

30 Table legs stood in wellington boots or buckets

31 Long curtains folded up and tied using old tights

32 Flood barriers to better protect patio doors and back doors and allow escape route

33 Puddle pump set up ready to remove any ingress of water down to as low as 1mm

34 Service vents covers/seals and self-closing airbricks

35 Water butts to collect rain from roof

36 Wall mounted TV

Sign up for warnings and make a plan

Firstly, if you live in an area that is at risk of flooding from a river, make sure you have signed up for free Environment Agency flood warning: gov.uk/get-flood-warnings

There are three flood warning codes:



FLOOD ALERT

A Flood Alert means that flooding is possible and that you need to be prepared



FLOOD WARNING

A Flood Warning means that flooding is expected and that you should take immediate action and not wait for a Severe Flood Warning.



SEVERE FLOOD WARNING

A Severe Flood Warning indicates significant danger from flooding and danger to life. Immediate action is required and the public should follow the advice of emergency services.

Make a Flood to-do list

If you are at risk of surface water flooding, sign up for the [Met Office weather alerts](#). You will need to act quickly, so it is essential to have a written flood plan/ to do list. When a warning comes, panic can easily take over – however a ‘to do list’ will help you go through things in a methodical way.

Think about what you would want to move out of harm’s way first. Don’t forget to add moving your car to that list as you don’t want a flooded car and a flooded house!

This flood to-do list template will give you some ideas to get started but remember, every household is unique. Tailor the plan to you, your needs and the people who live there.

Flood to-do list

How to plan for flooding

Flooding can happen quickly and often when you don’t expect it. Preparing a Household Flood Plan in advance of a flood will help you keep calm during a stressful situation. Once you have completed your Household Flood Plan, keep it close to hand and tell everyone in your family where it is. Don’t forget to update it when your circumstances change – for example, a change of school, new furniture etc.

Every house is different – so tailor this plan to suit you and your household. It is essential that you sign up for a free Environment Agency Flood Warning. Use this link www.gov.uk/get-flood-warnings

Before leaving your home to take photographs of each flooded area showing water levels and items in situ – it will assist you when preparing a claim with your insurance company. SECURE THE HOUSE!

FLOOD ALERT
A Flood Alert means that flooding is possible and that you need to be prepared.

FLOOD WARNING
A Flood Warning means that flooding is expected and that you should take immediate action. You should take action when a flood warning is issued and not wait for a Severe Flood Warning.

SEVERE FLOOD WARNING
A Severe Flood Warning means that flooding is severe flooding and danger to life. There should be immediate action. You should not wait for a Severe Flood Warning.

Here are a few hints for you when planning for a flood:

- Ensure adults in the household know where and how to turn off gas and electricity at the mains.
- Put important documents in a sealed plastic bag upstairs or on a high shelf. This includes marriage / birth / death certificates, insurance documents, wills, passports, property deeds etc. BETTER STILL MAKE COPIES AND KEEP THEM IN YOUR EMERGENCY KIT.
- Make sure precious photographs, mementos such as baby pictures, children’s drawings and wedding photos etc. are stored upstairs.
- Make a list of valuable household items. Write down a priority list for moving them to safety and hotel location.
- Keep a collection of blocks and plastic crates, bricks or planks of wood close to hand – in your shed perhaps. This will help you lift furniture off the ground. Write down where you are keeping them.
- Decide which room to designate for storage – you may all have to share one bedroom, make sure there is room!

Where could the contents of your lower cupboards go? Make soap powder and stuff in cardboard containers upstairs.


- Put heavier items at the bottom of the pile.
- Place vases or buckets under table legs to limit water damage
- Put plugs in sinks and weigh them down to stop backsplash.
- If time allows could you ask a friend / neighbour to please and store your frozen goods?

Kitchen

- Rugs, CDs, books, cushions etc... can all be put upstairs.
- Do you have fixed storage cupboards that need emptying?
- Have you disconnected audio / visual equipment from them or moved them upstairs, along with the television?
- Fold curtains upwards in half in-situ and tie securely with string.
- If you can't carry your sofas upstairs sand them up or moved them upstairs, and pile your other furniture on top of them.
- What about your paperwork and important documents?
- Is your computer or any other electrical equipment unplugged and lifted up high, along with wires?



It's always good to have a collection of lidded plastic boxes ready to store things in and move them higher or take them upstairs.



If you are alone when a flood is imminent, you can lift furniture using some wood as a lever, enabling you to slide some bricks in bags underneath



Lift sofas and chairs up onto decorators trestles (available at DIY and tool shops) and then put rugs and plastic boxes on top, out of the reach of flood water.



Look around your downstairs rooms and pack sentimental or valuable items into plastic boxes - things you'd be heartbroken to lose to flood water.



You can protect your table by using things you have in the house, like Wellington boots, buckets or waste paper bins. Stand the legs in them and then use the table top to stack your dining chairs.

Prepare your house

In an emergency and if you don't have any PFR products installed, then wide aluminium tape can be used over airbricks and around doors. I have recently tested this in a flood simulation tank and not a drop came through!



Use aluminium tape around the lower part of any doors, across the bottom and about half a metre up the sides.



Never forget any downstairs toilets! A toilet bung (see page 42) can be pushed down the loo and pumped up. If desperate try using a child's deflated football and push it hard down the loo, it may help to stop any sewage coming up your toilet. Failing that, invest in some large absorbent pads (see page 41). Shut the lid and use duct tape to hold the lid down. Also put the duct tape over any downstairs shower drain, if you have one and then put something heavy on top of it.



Tie your curtains up to lift them out of reach of the water with something like a pair of tights.

Permanent Resistance

Permanent/passive resistance products

are designed to stop flood water entering your home through existing openings, such as doors, windows or airbricks, or by preventing water from penetrating your walls.

To ensure these products work effectively when you need them most, it's essential to maintain them regularly, just like you would with your car or boiler.

Look out for products (particularly doors) that carry the British Standards Kitemark, BS851188, which shows they have been independently tested to a high standard. Some manufacturers may conduct their own tests but do check what independent testing has been used. Most doors are tested to withstand 0.6 metres of water.

Flood doors

A key entry point for flood water is through your doorways - forcing its way through the front entrance and leaving via the back door, destroying everything en-route.

This type of flooding could well be prevented, or at the very least lessened, by fitting a dedicated flood door - preferably Kitemarked to British Standards. Make sure they are installed by a suitably qualified professional who works to the **CIRIA Code of Practice (see page 77)**. With a large range of beautiful styles available, a flood door will act on your behalf, as long as it is locked, so you can be out at work, asleep or even on holiday in the Bahamas! Kitemarked flood doors allow a leakage rate, so consider keeping a supply of 'absorbent pads'.

I compare them to disposable nappies for giants and placed behind a door, they can soak up to approximately 20 litres of water.

Remember to have flood doors maintained annually, just as you would your car or boiler.





Flood windows

Just like with doorways, floodwater can also enter a home through a window. Floor to ceiling windows are very popular but they might not be able to withstand the pressure of floodwater up against them, and even deeper water puts higher windows to the test.

This risk can be reduced by fitting a 'Flood window'. Just like flood doors, make sure they are installed by a suitably qualified professional who works to the **CIRIA Code of Practice (see page 77)**. And, just like a flood door, they will act on your behalf when you are asleep or away from home, giving you that much needed peace of mind.

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

Auto barriers

Passive automatic flood barriers can be an ideal flood defence for residential dwellings, offering a reliable solution without the need for manual operation or electricity.

These systems are discreetly installed at entry points such as doors, garages or driveways, generally lying flush with the ground and automatically rising when flood water approaches. Activated only by the water itself, they provide effective and immediate protection even if the resident is not at home. Like other defences, a small amount of water is likely to get past these barriers, so it's important to think about how you manage that within your property.



Airbricks

In lower-level floods, airbricks are often the only way water enters a property. Some houses have multiple airbricks, which between them let a vast amount of water into a house, causing extensive damage. This can be stopped by replacing your standard airbrick with a self-closing airbrick, which closes automatically when floodwater arrives.

Submersible pumps

Floodwater can enter your home in many ways - not just through the front door or airbricks. In fact, many people say the first sign they were flooding was when their carpets suddenly became saturated. In these situations, installing a submersible pump in a sump chamber under the floor could help to keep water levels down.

Submersible pumps control the water level by pumping water out at a faster rate than it is entering. This manages the water level and stops it from rising significantly, which could cause damage to the building.

Temporary Resistance

Temporary resistance measures are aimed at keeping floodwater out of a building by putting in place devices that block doors, windows, airbricks, vents and pipes. In order to be protected, these products will need to be installed before flood water arrives. They are designed to lessen the damage that floodwater can do and also to give homeowners extra time to move ground floor contents. The measures may only be effective for a limited time and limited water depth.

These products will only keep water out if they are used correctly, as part of a wider package of measures. This should be based on a property-level flood protection survey carried out by a qualified surveyor (see page 63).

Flood barriers

Flood barriers work well but will need to be installed when you receive a flood warning - and be aware that it may be 3:30am and blowing a hooley outside so take a head torch as both your hands will be needed. Again, do look for a British Standard Kitemark product, BS851188 or check the standard of independent tests the manufacturer has used. Most barriers are designed and tested to withstand a water depth of 0.6 metres.

Sealing the walls

So far, you've seen the many products that can reduce the amount of water that gets into a home through the obvious routes, such as doors, airbricks, drains and from underneath. We mustn't forget that water can find its way into a property through less obvious vulnerabilities -like the walls. This section shows many materials that can reduce the amount of water that gets in. Some of it can be undertaken by someone good at DIY but it is always best to seek professional help before undertaking large scale work.

External walls: have a good look at the outside of your property and repair any suspect mortar and cracked bricks, preferably using waterproof and breathable mortar. Also on the market are sealants, which will slow down the ingress of water through brickwork but, at the same time, will allow the bricks to breath.

Internal walls: After a flood, if your property is stripped out, ask whoever is repairing your property to apply a fillet of waterproof slurry internally where the walls meet the floor. This is a weak spot and often a common entry point for water. You could also consider tanking the walls, but this work should always be undertaken by a professional company who specialise in tanking.





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

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CASE STUDY

Botcherby Community Centre was badly flooded in both 2005 and 2015. The kitchen was still a shell 19 months later so it was decided it should be made resilient to future floods by repairing it using flood resilient materials.

The internal wall was made 'flood recoverable'. The plaster board was applied horizontally, so it could simply be removed and replaced with new plasterboard.



A double-layered replastering system was used, the first was the Dryzone Damp Resistant Plaster Flood System, which is a waterproof and salt retardant plaster, which owing to its porous structure will dry down very quickly should future flooding occur.

The second system was the Dryzone Drygrip Waterproof Adhesive Express Flood System. This is a plasterboard system using a waterproof and salt retardant adhesive. The advantage of this system is that it can be replaced very quickly with minimal disturbance should future flooding occur.

The walls were then skimmed using Dryzone Hi-Lime Finishing Plaster. Finally, we applied two coats of Drybase Liquid-Applied DPM to the floor. Once applied this product cures to form a waterproof membrane that is flexible and elastic. These changes mean the centre is now far better prepared to recover quickly if flooding happens again.





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

7 Greening up your garden



Paul lives in a rented property in Hull. He didn't flood in 2007. He says he owes this to the fact that his front garden was not paved over with a hard standing but kept as a lawn and therefore was slightly higher up.

Nearby neighbours, who had paved over their gardens, did flood. He also has a long back garden, which has a lawn and trees. He has a large shed from which he has fixed guttering to harvest any rainwater into two water butts and the excess is piped onto the garden. If everyone made some small changes like this, it could make a difference to our overall flood risk.

Outside spaces

[The Rain Garden](#), sponsored by Flood Re, featured at the Malvern Spring Festival 2025 and was inspired by the changing climate and flood risks that urban



environments face. Through innovative rainwater harvesting techniques like elegant rain chains, swales, and troughs, the garden demonstrated that not only can we alleviate the challenges of flooding, but also create a serene, biodiverse oasis that nurtures both people and planet.

The Flood Resilient Garden will be open to the public free of charge at [Howbery Business Park](#) in Oxfordshire from Summer 2025. The Rain Garden has been relocated to Coppermill Primary School in Walthamstow and will provide much-needed solutions to the school's flooding issues.

Connect a water butt to your downpipe

Available in all shapes and sizes, water butts may be made of plastic, wood, or metal and even repurposed materials. Improve the efficiency of rainwater capture by connecting your water butt to a downpipe and make

Direct water with rain chains

This ancient method originating in Japan assists with rainwater collection. Traditionally attached to eaves and gutters, not only do they effectively aid rainwater capture, but rain chains look great too!



Reduce water loss and usage

Make sure to cover your water butt with a lid to help protect it. This will help prevent unwanted debris gathering and help to reduce evaporation – so there is more water for you to use. Make the most of this precious resource by using a watering can for plants and outdoor spaces.

Create a rain garden

These shallow landscaped areas can be planted with shrubs and plants, which help to absorb water instead of it rushing into drainage systems or across hard surfaces. You can even direct water from your rooftop into rain gardens and your plants prefer it to tap water!

Did you know, there are many ways to capture rainwater?

Rain Planters

These are a type of water butt with planting space for flowers, herbs or other small plants at the top. They're a fantastic way to brighten up your outdoor space, slowing the flow whilst improving biodiversity! Like a standard water butt, they can be connected to your downpipes.



Leaky Water Butts

Leaky water butts include a small pipe part way up the tank. Once water reaches this point, it is slowly released, instead of the water butt overflowing. Installing a tap means you have access to stored water for your plants and outdoor spaces.

Smart Water Butts

Combining tech and nature! Smart water butts optimise water collection, storage and release through sensors and smart home systems. Release water at the push of a button to make space before a heavy downpour!

What is a rain garden?

A rain garden is a small recessed garden area, planted full of plants that enjoy more boggy conditions. You will be directing the water coming from a downspout on the side of your property into the rain garden, and then out the other side of the garden to a drainage area. This can be achieved by connecting more downspout or digging a small trench and lining it with pebbles (to prevent erosion).

Rain gardens help hold back the water, and filter it, before it enters the storm-water system. It also adds a great biodiversity habitat!


What to Consider

Location:

Your rain gardens needs to be more than 3m away from any property foundations, but not so far that you can't connect the garden to the downspout. The outlet point of the rain garden needs to be facing an area that is safe to direct excess water away from your house, and not into the neighbours either. If you are planting on a sloped area, ensure the ground is not sloping towards your house. Be aware of services that may run underground (check at lsbud.co.uk)

Drainage:

In an ideal world, your soil will drain at about 1 inch per hour. Once you've decided where you want your garden to go, dig a slim hole (approx 10cm in diameter, and 15cms deep), fill it with water, and come back in an hour to see how much has soaked



away. If your soil is draining really slowly, you can either change location or just dig your rain garden a little deeper.

Size:

The size of your rain garden should be about 10% the area of the roof that will be sending water to your chosen downspout. This will not necessarily be your whole house's roof. You should aim to have a depth of roughly 1ft in the centre of the garden, gently sloping upwards.

Shape:

Your rain garden can be any shape that suits your aesthetic! Create a bund with the soil you dig up

around the lower-lying edges of the garden, to make sure the 'walls' are level, and will contain the water.

Connecting your garden to the downspout:

This can be done in one of two ways.

Option 1: Attaching another piece of downpipe onto the end of your downspout, and positioning it to allow water to flow directly to the inlet point of your rain garden.

Option 2: Digging a shallow trench from your downspout to the inlet point of your rain garden, and filling it with pebbles (to prevent erosion).
